Proposed Questionnaire may kindly be raised in the ensuing Budget Session of Parliament:-

- 1) Whether the Government of India is aware of the Non viable conditions of the Fair Price Shops if so, what steps are being contemplated to ensure their viability atleast @ Rs. 50,000/- only per month per Shop by enhancement of Margin.
- 2) Whether In the "eventualities like non availability of Network, Server remaining down, mismatch of fingerprints, alternative arrangements like supplying Ration by inserting Aadhar Nos. should be ensured" to minimize harassment of the Rationees.
- 3) In this context, whether any Clear cut & categorical Government order not to deprive any Ration card holder in such situation is issued. What is the problem in this regard in issuance of a formal order.
- 4) Whether Central Govt. has any contemplation to sale Rice & Wheat under open market sale scheme (Domestic) through the Fair Price Shops to help the general consumers to buy at Govt. specified rates.
- 5) Whether the Central Govt. has any contemplation to allot cereals according to NFSA since there is no allotment is being given under this Act, only five kg foodgrains is being allowed under PKGKAY.
- 6) Is the Union Government not inclined to appreciate the ground reality of Handling Loss being incurred by the Fair Price Shop Dealers during Distribution of Ration and stacking & storing of stocks and allow them Handling Loss @ 01 kg per quintal so as to enable the Dealers to justify the shortages on this count Without shouldering any responsibility to the State Govts & UTs.
- 7) Whether any contemplation to supply Cereals on 100% weighment at the time of doorstep delivery at Fair Price Shops followed by NFSA is being made mandatory.
- 8) Whether any proposal of Govt. to direct the State Governments to assess the minimum number of beneficiaries to be linked with a Fair Price Shop for ensuring the minimum turn over of a Fair Price Shop in strict compliance of TPDS Control Order (Para 9, Sub Clause 5 & 6) to make it viable.
- 9) Whether the Govt. has any proposal to amend the National Food Security Act. and assess making Rationalisation of beneficiaries which could bring the viability amongst the Fair Price Shops of an area. Moreover, without assessing the viability of existing Fair Price Shops, Licenses for new Shops are being given making matters worse for the existing Shops.
- 10) Whether the Union Govt. has any proposal to include other schemes for the Fair Price Shop Dealers to make their business viable.
- 11) Whether the Union Govt. has any contemplation to allow sell of other than NFSA items without giving any responsibility to the States/UTs Government.
