In the above context, we beg to solicit your kind attention to the fact that we have been kept in a state of financial doldrum with our "Ration Dealer's Margins" remaining almost the same, other benefits neglected and negated and our cries falling on deaf ears.

In fact, it is most pathetic that consequent upon our continued agitation, Govt. of India was compelled to entrust the responsibility of reviewing our Margins to an International Organization – World Food Program. The Organization duly submitted their Report & Recommendations as back as in the year 2020 but, unfortunately, the Union Govt. has preferred to sleep over it while we are almost in a near starvation state.

We would incidentally mention that Govt. of India has recently considered a raise of only 20 paisa per kg in our Margin as a cruel joke adding insult to our injury.

A brief summary of our Long - Standing Demands :-

- 1) A minimum Margin of Rs. 440/- (Rupees four hundred forty) per quintal must be ensured with a Minimum Monthly Income Guarantee of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only.
- 2) Handling Loss for Rice, Wheat & Sugar should be allowed @ 1 kg per quintal.
- 3) Edible Oil & Pulses should be supplied through Fair Price Shops.
- 4) LPG Gas Cylinders should be supplied through Fair Price Shops.

Fair Price Shops will collect LPG Cylinders from the LPG Distributors and make doorstep delivery to the LPG Consumers tagged to their Fair Price Shops. The Margin will be shared equally by the LPG Distributors & the Fair Price Shops.

- 5) We will stop lifting of stocks unless they are supplied in Jute gunny bags.
- 6) Allowing the Fair Price Shop Dealers of the Rural areas to function as "Direct Procurement Agents (DPA)" for Rice & Wheat.
- 7) "West Bengal Ration Model" of free distribution of Ration to all Indian Citizens i.e. "Food for All" be implemented throughout the Country.
- 8) All Due Margins for all the States including Jammu & Kashmir should be reimbursed immediately.
- 9) Compensation of Corona victim Dealers should be paid @ Rs. 50 Lakhs as granted by the State of Rajasthan.
