HAND OUT

Yesterday 08.06.2022, Wednesday a meeting of National Federation was organized at “Muktodhara Auditorium”, New Delhi in the presence of 22 (twenty two) State representatives.

National Committee passed many motions in this meeting which have been pending for years together.

The Fair Price Shop Dealers have been always serving more than 81 crores Beneficiaries under adverse conditions, especially during the COVID – 19 in which many of our fellow – Dealers lost their lives but despite that the FPS Dealers have been continuing their service but the FPS Dealers are not given their legitimate claim, hence the Dealers of the Country demand economic security in the shape of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only per month as Minimum Monthly Income Guarantee and enhancement of margins as recommended by the “World Food Program” appointed by the Govt. of India submitted their report in February, 2020.

The Union Government instead has granted an alm of only 20 paise per kg for the General Category States & 37 paise per kg for the Hilly & North-Eastern States as a cruel joke.

We expect an announcement by the Union Food Ministry after meeting with us this month and the Hon'ble Union Food Minister, Shri Piyush Goyal Ji is also expected to meet us sometime between 13th to 17th June.

There are, however, some silver linings also and I am informing all of you in brief :-

1. Government of India is trying to explore the ways & means for enhancing the viability of Fair Price Shops.
2. They are going to do away with the decision of some State Governments to supply Ration at the doorsteps of the Consumers and for the purpose, a separate Cabinet Note is on the way.
3. The Union Food Ministry is also going to take – up the matter with the Indian Jute Mills' Association to ensure supply of Rice, Wheat & Sugar in jute gunny bags replacing supply in Polymer bags.
4. They are also seriously thinking over the matter relating to grant of Handling Loss which is a reality to the FPS Dealers.
5. They are further going to pressurize the defaulting State Governments / UTs to allow the Fair Price Shops to function as "Common Service Centres" in compliance with the order already issued in this regard by the Union Government.
6. Our prayer for allowing the FPS Dealers of the Rural areas to function as "Direct Procurement Agents (DPA)" for Rice & Wheat is also under consideration.
7. We have demanded that immediate orders be issued for supply of Edible Oil & Pulses to the NFSA Consumers in the backdrop of the spiralling prices of these commodities.
8. Moreover, subsidy for Petrol, Diesel, Kerosene & LPG has already been done away with and the PDS has been put in such a position that has made the FPS Dealers "gasping for breath".

We have no time to wait for an indefinite period. Hence, we demand that the Union Government adopts the following immediate within this month, June 2022 :-

- A minimum Margin of Rs. 440/- (Rupees four hundred forty) per quintal must be ensured.
- Handling Loss for Rice, Wheat & Sugar should be allowed @ 1 kg per quintal.
- Edible Oil & Pulses should be supplied through Fair Price Shops.
- LPG Gas Cylinders should be supplied through Fair Price Shops. Fair Price Shops will collect LPG Cylinders from the LPG Distributors and make doorstep delivery to the LPG Consumers tagged to their Fair Price Shops. The Margin will be shared equally by the LPG Distributors & the Fair Price Shops.
- We will stop lifting of stocks unless they are supplied in Jute gunny bags.
- "West Bengal Ration Model" of free distribution of Ration to all Indian Citizens i.e. Food for All be implemented throughout the Country.

Unless our above demands are met we shall have no other alternative but to start our agitation with following programs :-

- On 4th July, 2022 – Agitation to all Block levels.
- On 11th July, 2022 – Agitation to all Sub - Divisional levels.
- On 18th July, 2022 – Agitation program at all State Capitals.
